How many people are there?

How long is the play?

How long do you work?

#### ¿Cuánto?

It costs six dollars.

There are twenty people.

It lasts two hours,

I work eight hours.

Where is the library?  
 Where are you going?  
 Where are you from?

**¿Dónde?**

It's at the university.  
 I'm going to the movies.  
 I'm from Sonora.

**Vocabulario**

<b>la biblioteca</b>	person	<b>el cine</b>	the movies
<b>ir</b>	to go	<b>la universidad</b>	the university

**How?**

How is your father?  
 How does this work (function)?  
 How do I get to (arrive at) Nogales?

**¿Cómo?**

He is well.  
 You need to press the button.  
 You need to take the highway.

**Vocabulario**

<b>funcionar</b>	to work, function	<b>llegar a</b>	to get to, arrive at
<b>presionar</b>	to press	<b>la carretera</b>	highway
<b>el botón</b>	button		

**Why?**

Why is the man sad?  
 Why are there clouds?

**¿Por qué?**

Because he doesn't have money.  
 Because the weather is going to change.

**Vocabulario**

<b>triste</b>	sad	<b>el tiempo, el clima</b>	the weather
<b>dinero</b>	money	<b>cambiar</b>	to change
<b>las nubes</b>	clouds		

**What?**

What is this?  
 What are these?  
 What time is it?  
 What kind of flower do you like?  
 What else (more) do you like?  
 What do you like to do?  
 What does a word mean?

**¿Qué?**

It's a (credit) card  
 They're tickets (for the movies).  
 It's two o'clock in the afternoon.  
 I like roses.  
 I like tulips too.  
 I like to play golf.  
 It means...

**Vocabulario**

**Which?**

Which shirt do you want?  
 What's the problem?  
 What's today's date?  
 What's your favorite movie?  
 What's your telephone number?  
 What's the capital of Columbia?

**¿Cuál?**

I want the red shirt.  
 I don't have the money.  
 It's April 11th  
 It's Coco.  
 It's...  
 It's Bogota.

**Vocabulario**

<b>el problema</b>	problem	<b>la capital</b>	the capital
<b>la fecha</b>	(calendar) date		

**Otras preguntas**

Can I help you?  
 Do you play the piano?  
 Do you have a ticket?  
 Do you have to wait?  
 Are you going to help me?  
 Would you like something to drink?  
 Do you like the movie?

**Other questions**

Yes, I'm looking for a cap.  
 No, I can't play it.  
 No, I need to buy it.  
 Yes, there is a line.  
 Yes, in a moment.  
 Yes, I would like a coffee  
 Yes, it's very funny.
