

Remember that all verbs* are accented on the next-to-last syllable in the present tense.

Yo camino

I walk

Tú decides

You decide

Ella aprende

She learns

Nosotros jugamos

We play

Ellos comen

They eat

*Except ESTAR (estoy. Estás, está, están)



Conversación intermedia 1
El orden de las palabras

Subject – Verb – Object

José lava el carro.

Jose washes the car.

Ana y yo cocinamos la cena.

Ana and I cook dinner.

Substituting a Definite Article for the Object

José lo lava. (el carro)

Jose cleans it. (the car)

Ana y yo la cocinamos. (la cena)

Ana and I cook it. (dinner)

Pronoun Subject -Verb – Object

(Él) lava el carro.

He washes the car.

(Nosotros) cocinamos la cena.

We cook dinner.

Definite Article – Verb (No Subject Noun or Pronoun)

Lo lava. (el carro)

He washes it. (the car)

La cocinamos. (la cena)

We cook it. (dinner)



El orden de las palabras

Nota especial:

In this class we have not covered the indirect object in sentences. We will introduce indirect objects in the Intermediate II class.

Ejemplos:

María le da el libro a Juan.
Se lo da a Juan.

Maria gives the book to Juan.
She gives it to Juan.

-ER, -IR Verbs:

-iendo

Comiendo (Comer)

Aprendiendo (Aprender)

Escribiendo (Escribir)

Saliendo (Salir)

El gerundio

¿Por qué el gerundio?

Because you can combine it with a verb you know very well (estar) with thousands of other verbs to quickly describe actions:

Estoy estudiando

Estamos comiendo

María está caminando

Mis amigos están saliendo

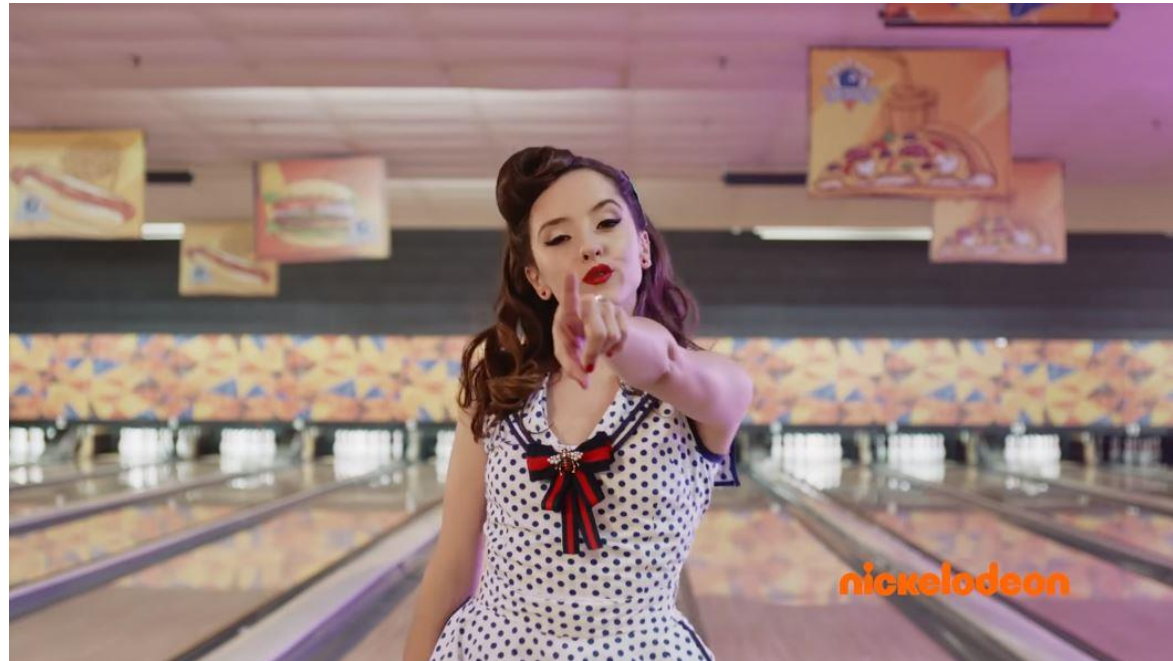
